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A BUTTERFLY WIND CHIMES



FIND SOME WOOD AND GLUE. A STICK FROM OUTSIDE OR SPOON FROM INSIDE.



AN INSECT HAS 3 BODY PARTS. DRAW LINES TO MAKE SURE YOU HAVE 3 PARTS.



COLOUR EACH SECTION DIFFERENT. PAINT, CRAYONS OR FELT TIPS?



INSECTS HAVE 6 LEGS BUT A BUTTERFLY HAS 2 AT THE TOP. TWIST TIES WORK WELL.



4 NAILS TIED WITH FISHING WIRE FOR THE BOTTOM 4 LEGS.



ATTACH THEM TO THE BOTTOM SO THAT THEY CAN BANG TOGETHER AND CHIME.



USE DECORATIVE PAPER OR EVEN COLOUR AND DESIGN YOUR OWN.

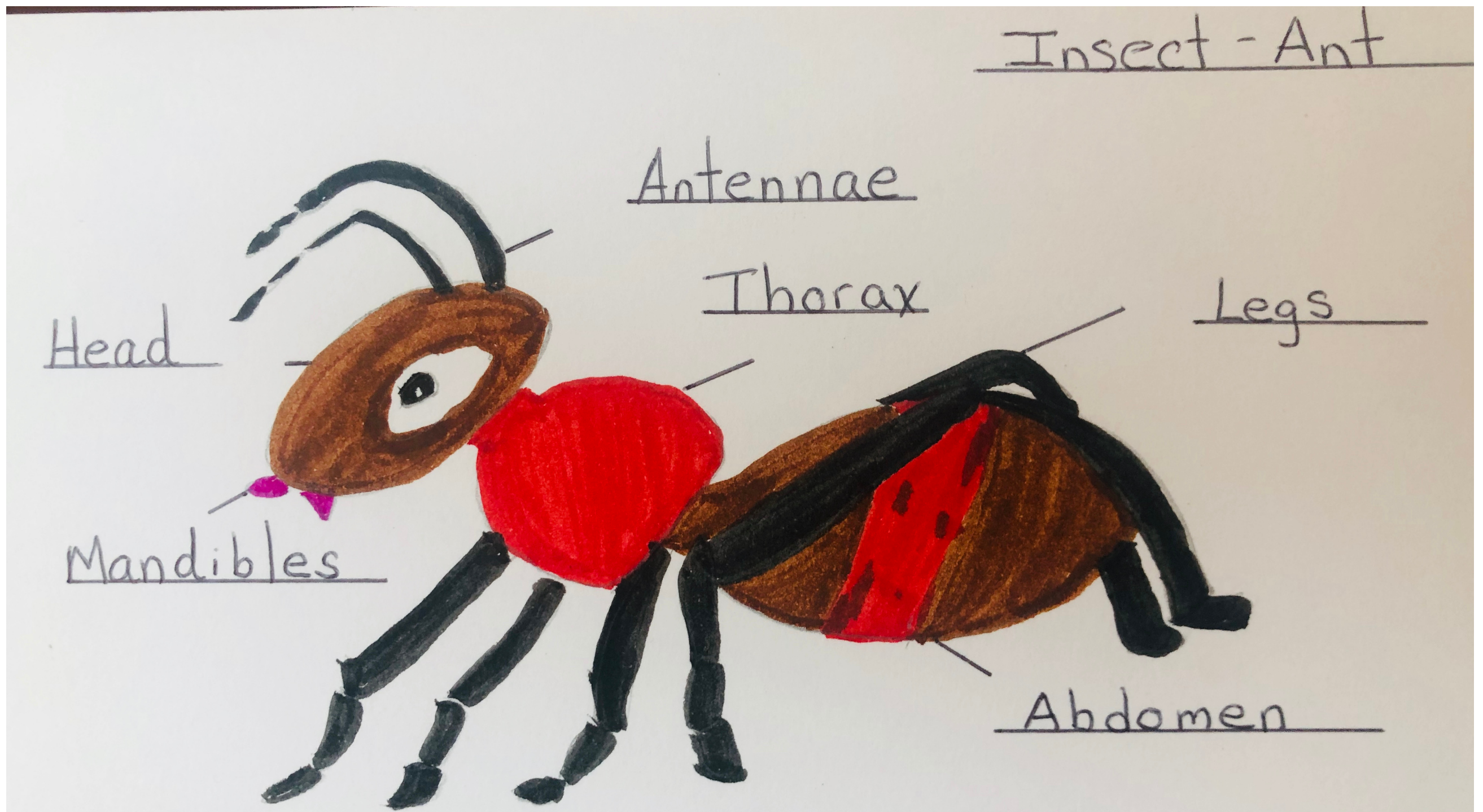


CUT OUT THE WINGS IN PAIRS OR AS ONE PIECE.

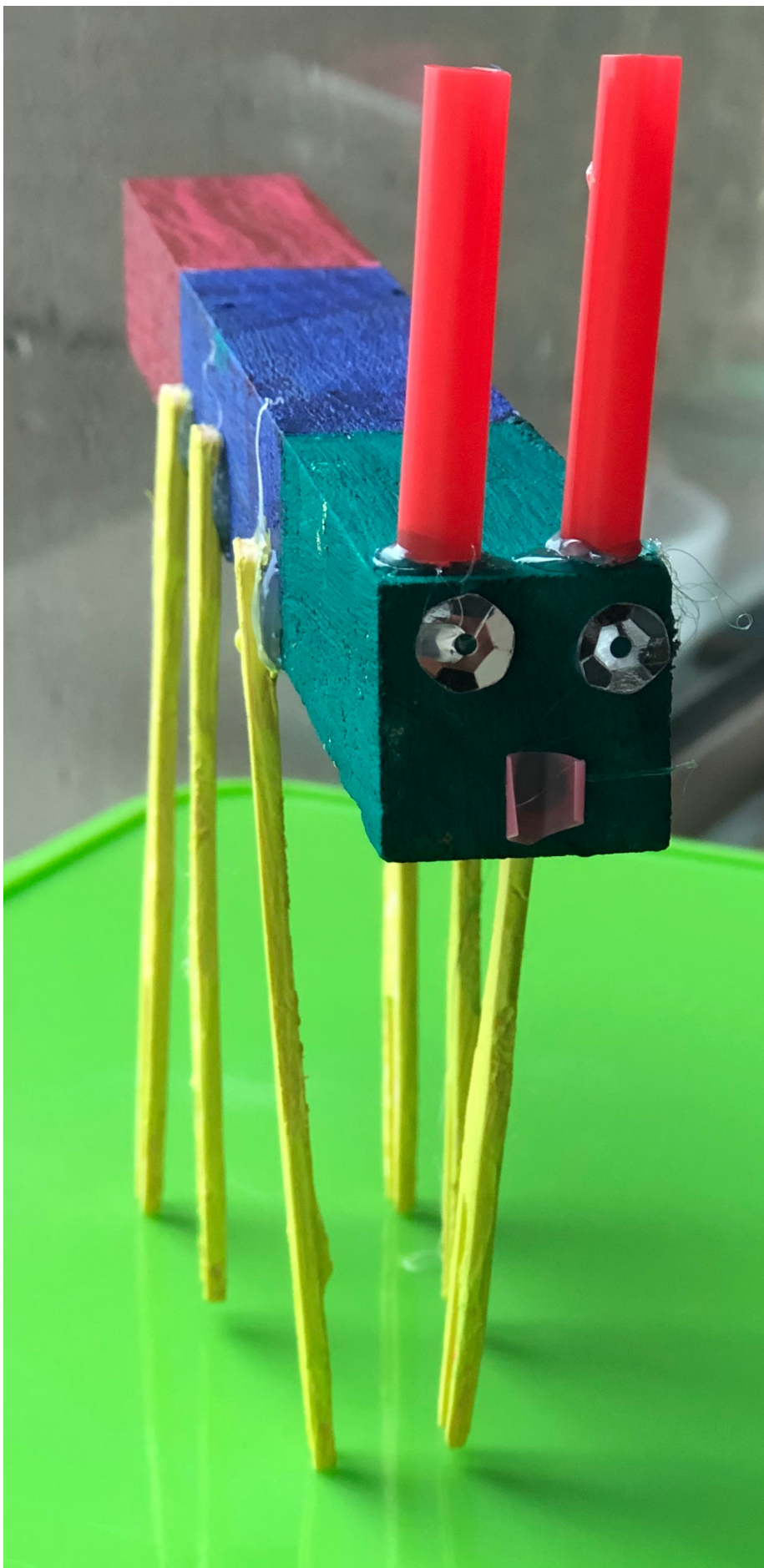

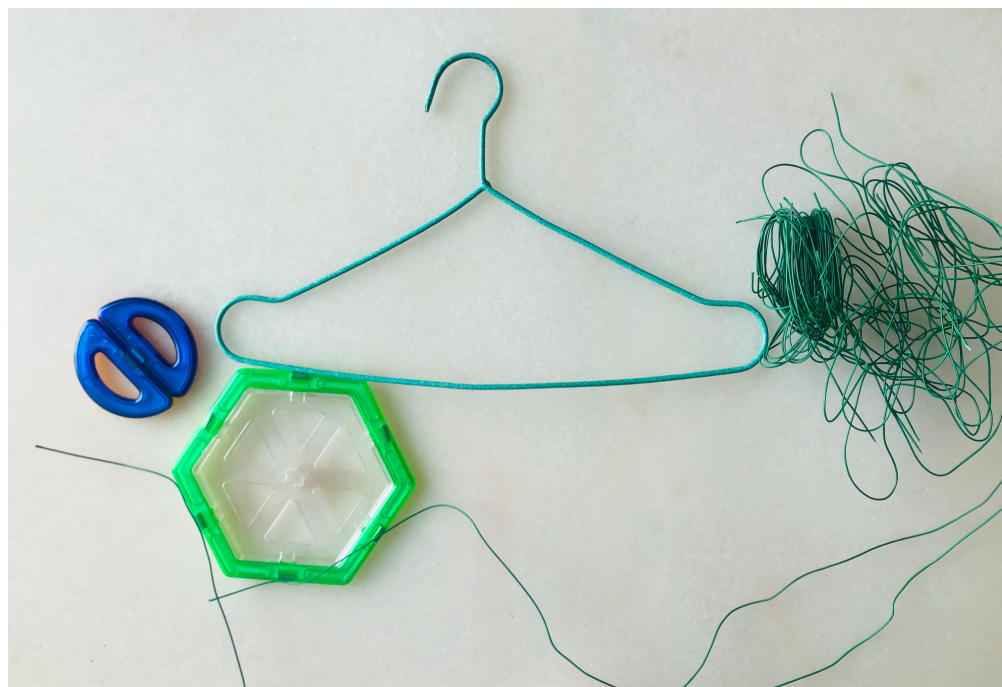

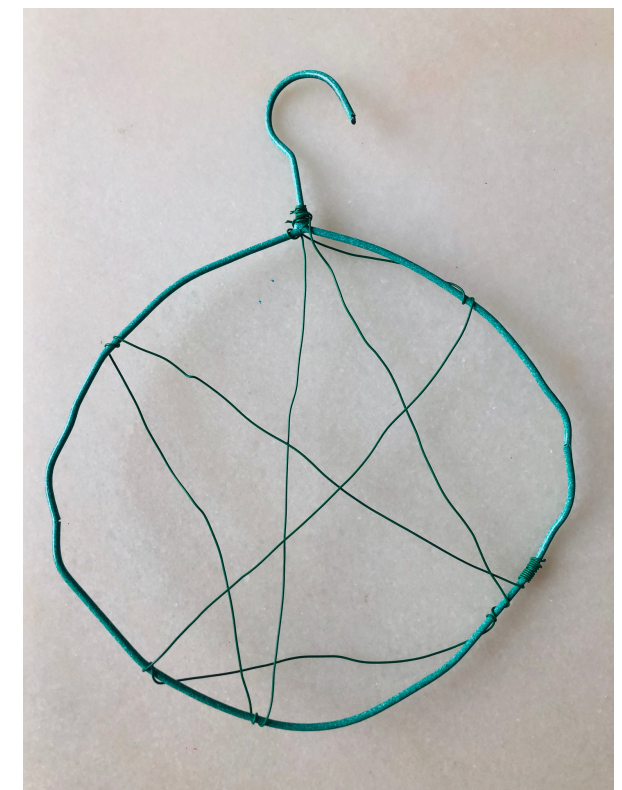
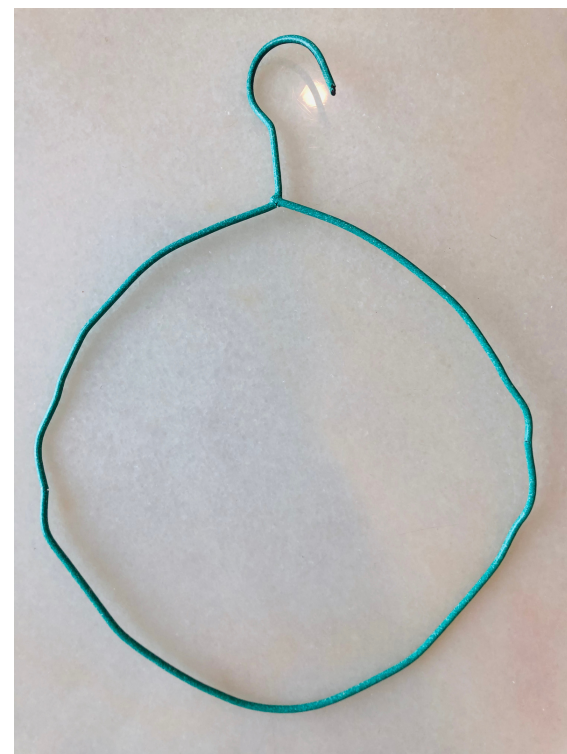
SPIDERS ARE NOT INSECTS

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TRY THIS CRAFT TO DISCOVER HOW SPIDERS DIFFER FROM INSECTS



YOU'LL NEED A METAL HANGER, WIRE AND A MAGNET. AS WELL AS GLUE/TAPE, PAPER AND SCISSORS.



PULL THE HANGER TO MAKE A CIRCLE AND TWIST AROUND THE WIRE TO MAKE A WEB



CUT OUT TWO CIRCLES



8 LEGS



WE USED A SMALLER MAGNET. PLACED ON A CIRCLE WITH DOUBLE SIDED TAPE



STICK ON THE SECOND CIRCLE AND 8 LEGS



DECORATE AND USE THE MAGNET TO STICK TO THE WIRES
